Visits	Visits can be booked for half a day (up to 3 hours, including a 15 minute break) or a full day (up to 5 hours, including a 15 minute morning break and a 45 minute lunch break)
Set up / Packing Away Time	It takes an hour to set up the display and 40 minutes to pack away. Please remember this if the hall is needed for a breakfast club or after school activity.
Maximum number of children	Sessions can be run for a maximum of 30 children at one time
Primary School Workshops: Session length and content	Sessions last between 30 and 75 minutes. KS1 sessions usually last 30 minutes and KS2, 45 to 75 minutes. 30 minute sessions include an introductory talk, a look around the collection and time for questions and answers 45 minute sessions also include a slideshow created by The Nature Collection. They are age appropriate and contain colourful photos of the local wildlife and the collection contents. 60 – 75 minute sessions also include an Activity Sheet for the children. Owl Pellet workshops take 75 minutes.
Nurseries (Age 2 to 4)	Children are given a very hands-on talk about the collection in small groups of 6 – 10. Sessions last about 15 minutes for each group. Different objects are talked about and passed round, then the children look at the rest of the collection. They enjoy using magnifying glasses, trying on the antlers and feeling the feathers and wings.

Owl Pellet workshops can be run for one year group per day. An additional charge of £15 per workshop applies, to pay for disposable gloves for up to 30 children. It also covers the cost of providing the pellets, trays and tweezers. Owl Pellet sessions last 75 minutes, plus 20 minutes afterwards (without children) to clear away, before the next session begins. The session includes an introductory talk, a look around the display, a slideshow about Owls and Owl Pellets and approximately 20 minutes, dissecting a pellet in small groups.
Prices do not include the cost of photocopying the Activity Sheets. These are e:mailed to the school before the visit.
Please do not take videos or extensive photos of the exhibits or slideshow presentations. You are encouraged to take photos of the children enjoying the collection, trying on the antlers and using the magnifying glasses.
